Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.22 dated 21.02.2016, under Sections 379-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

FIR was registered on the statement of Naval Mahajan with the allegations that on 21.02.2016 while the complainant was proceeding on an Aactiva scooter along with his wife and daughter, two clean shaved persons on Royal Enfield motorcycle black colour came from behind at a high speed and snatched a small brown purse held by wife of the complainant and which was containing one mobile phone (Lava company) and Rs.300/-.

Petitioner is stated to have been arrested on the same very date i.e. on 21.02.2016.

Prosecution version is that recovery of the mobile phone as also Rs.300/- has been effected from the present petitioner.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other criminal proceedings and possesses clean antecedents otherwise.

Be that as it may, investigation in the case has been completed and challan stands presented.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
