Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.101 dated 21.05.2014, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was 150 grams of intoxicating powder. On receipt of the report of the Chemical Examiner, the same was found to be containing alprazolam.

Concededly, the alleged recovery would fall under the commercial quantity.

Under such circumstances, the prayer of the petitioner seeking benefit of regular bail is declined.

Petition stands dismissed.
