Petitioners seek benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.119 dated 09.12.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner as also from the co-accused is of 400 tablets of microlit. As per chemical examiner report, the same was found to be containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride salt.

It stands conceded that the alleged recovery would fall under the non-commercial quantity.

Petitioners have faced incarceration since 09.12.2015.

Investigation in the case is complete and even challan stands presented.

Petitioners are not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Petition is allowed. Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
