The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of ASI-Punnu Ram alleging that on 23.11.2015, he had received a secret information that 4/5 tractor-trolleys were being used for extracting sand by few persons. The accused persons escaped from the spot. Ram Singh and Yogesh Arora, two persons, were arrested from the spot. The name of the petitioner was allegedly disclosed by the co-accused of the petitioner.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 25.12.2015. The trial is likely to take a long time.

No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
