Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.47 dated 3.7.2013 under section 379 I.P.C and section 21 of Mines and Mineral Act, registered at Police Station, Dera Baba Nanak, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the present petition. He further submits that the petitioner is otherwise ready and willing to surrender before the Trial Court and prays that, if, thereafter an application for bail is filed, directions be issued for deciding such application on the same very day.

As per prayer made by counsel, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner duly surrenders before the Trial Court on or before the date already fixed and thereafter files an application for bail, the same would be considered on merits and the court would make every endeavor for disposal of the same.

Petition disposed of.
