Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.40 dated 21.06.2012, under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dhanaula City Barnala, District Barnala.

As per prosecution, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is heavy and commercial in nature.

Be that as it may, this Court cannot proceed oblivious of the fact that the petitioner was taken into custody on 24.06.2012 and has faced incarceration since then. Charges are stated to have been framed on 01.11.2012. Trial has till date not been concluded.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Bhola Singh would apprise the Court that the prosecution evidence has since been completed.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and in any case to conclude the same within a period of three months from today.
