INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.503 dated 12.11.2005 (date of FIR has been wrongly mentioned as 12.11.2015 in the order of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon), registered at Police Station Udyog Vihar, District Gurgaon, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

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learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Perusal of the file reveals that the petitioner absented himself from the Appellate Court on 15.09.2015 and subsequently on four dates, on account of which he apprehends his arrest pursuant to non-bailable warrants issued.

In pursuance of the order dated 22.03.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Appellate Court and has been released on interim bail vide order dated 29.03.2016. The order dated 29.03.2016 further shows that even a penalty of ₹25,000/- has been imposed upon the petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C. The said penalty amount has been paid by the petitioner. Copy of the order dated 29.03.2016 is taken on record.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 22.03.2016 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
