During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused, Hanish Thakur and against whom there were identical allegations has been granted benefit of bail in the light of order dated 01.04.2016 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Petitioner has been in custody since 08.10.2015.

Without touching upon the merits of the case and on the ground of parity itself, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.321 dated 18.10.2014, under Sections 392/336/34 IPC (challan presented under Sections 392/336/473/411 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act), registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali.
