Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.5.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4, only at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajpreet S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that representations dated December 08, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and December 10, 2015 (Annexure P-1) were moved to respondents No.3 and 4 but till date no action has been taken on those representations. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case representation dated December 08, 2015 (Annexure P-2) moved by petitioners to respondent No.2 is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.

5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated December 08, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
