This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.555 dated 31.12.2015 under sections 21, 22-C, 27-A, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, based on secret information alleged recovery of 52 bottles of Joly Rest (Rexcof) 100 ml in each bottle, was effected from Navdeep @ Deepu.

Petitioner was not apprehended on the spot and neither any recovery effected from him.

Present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the disclosure statement of main accused Navdeep Singh @ Deepu and who had stated that he had purchased contraband from the present petitioner.

Contention raised by counsel for the petitioner as regards false implication cannot be discarded.

Petitioner was arrested on 2.1.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan stands presented and even charges have been framed.

Trial is stated to be at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the N.D.P.S Act.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.

Petition disposed of.
