This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking setting aside of order dated March 03, 2016 passed by the Id. Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad in bail application No. 67, dated 29.02.2016, captioned as "*Vijay Kumar vs. State of Haryana*" (Annexure P-8) whereby the petitioner has been directed to make the balance payment as per the agreement, within a period of 7 days and interim bail was granted to respondent No.2- Vijay Kumar.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of order dated March 03, 2016 passed by Id. Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad,

some balance amount outstanding against the petitioner was required to be deposited within a 7 days and only thereafter, the respondent was to complete the installation of modular kitchen within 35 days but the condition of balance payment has not been complied with. Thus, there is nothing to interfere in the impugned order. As such, the present petition is dismissed.
