This is an application for condonation of delay of 385 days in filing the present appeal.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, delay of 385 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

CRM stands disposed of.

CRM-A No.500-MA of 2014

This application has been filed against the acquittal of the accused persons in a complaint case registered under Section 295-A, 323, 341, 452, 506, 34 IPC.

As per allegations, nine accused persons had attacked the applicant and caused simple injuries to him because of party faction. The Courts below accepted the plea of alibi of one of the accused Darshan Singh and the exculpatory statement of another witness as well as the fact that no medical examination was conducted, to come to the conclusion that the applicant had not succeeded in proving his case beyond reasonable doubt.

In view of the above facts, it cannot be disputed that some

doubt can be cast on the story put forward by the applicant.

Consequently, the application stands dismissed.
