The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 255 dated 25.07.2015 registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal under Sections 306/406 IPC.

Heard.

The deceased was married to the petitioner in 2006. She died unnatural death in the matrimonial home. On 25.07.2015 the FIR was lodged by the brother. The police has filed the challan and the petitioner is facing trial. He was arrested on 01.08.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the complainant had entered into a compromise with the Jethani of the deceased and the complainant had levelled allegations that the petitioner was having illicit relations with Jethani and bail should be allowed to the petitioner.

Pooja had committed suicide and the husband had been challaned. The other people named in the complaint have been let off. The complainant had alleged harassment. He had also hinted at the extra marital affairs of the husband. No clean chit has been given to the petitioner,

Considering the seriousness of the allegations, no case for bail is made out. The trial is yet to start. The petition is dismissed.
