Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Sanbeep and Pardeep in case FIR No.37 dated 22.02.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 325, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, District Kaithal, Haryana.

It is apparent that both the aforesaid petitioners are attributed one *Gandasi* blow (incised wound as per MLR P-2) each on the non vital parts of the complainant i.e. Right hand index finger and on the right knee.

It is contended that both the sides are property dealers and there

is previous history of infliction of injuries between the parties. Initially

notice of motion was issued and *inter alia* also for exploring the process of amicable settlement. The same however, has not materialise.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and cooperated in the same.

Learned State counsel assisted by SI Rajvir Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 04th of April, 2016/11th May of 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
