Counsel, at the very outset, prays for withdrawal of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.54 dated 15.05.2013, under Sections 382, 34 of Indian Penal Code (later on added Section 392, 411, 34 of IPC), registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

Counsel, however, submits that the petitioner would duly surrender before the trial Court within a period of five days from today and prays that if thereafter an application for bail is filed, directions be issued for deciding such application forthwith.

As per statement made by counsel, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking bail, the same would be decided strictly on merits and Court would make an endeavour to expedite disposal of the same.
