This is a petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 03.02.2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sarai Khawaja, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations made by the complainant Suresh Singh son of Angad Singh as regards misappropriation of a sum of Rs.7 lacs on the pretext of selling a plot are against co-acused Gajender, Anu and Sultan Singh Rawat and not against the present petitioner. He further submits that even as per complainant, the entrustment of Rs.7 lacs was to the aforementioned three accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on 25.04.2016.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. On the other hand, learned State counsel, submits that though, the petitioner has joined the investigation but he is not cooperating in investigation. He further states that the petitioner who was admitted to interim bail vide order dated 25.04.2016, has misused the concession of bail and another FIR No.304 dated 22.05.2015 under Section 420 IPC has been registered at Police Station Sarai against the petitioner.

Keeping in view of the conduct of the petitioner this Court feels that the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail. Consequently, petition is dismissed.
