This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.07 dated 08.01.2016, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 29.03.2016:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.07 dated 08.01.2016, under Section 174-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka.

It is submitted that the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in criminal complaint No.184/2 dated 28.08.2015 CIS No. NACT-764/2015 under the provisions of Negotiable Instruments Act. Counsel would contend that the petitioner had never been served and as such was not aware of the proceedings. It is also the categoric submission made by counsel that the complaint had been lodged by the Canara

Bank and the entire dues have since been settled by the present petitioner. Even the 'No Dues Certificate' issued by the complainant Bank has been placed on record at Annexure P-2.

Notice of motion, returnable for 18.05.2016.

Meanwhile, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that statement of Pawan Kumar, Manager Canara Bank, Branch Village Mozgarh, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka has been recorded and in terms of which the present petitioner has already settled the entire dues with the complainant Bank.

In view of such stand taken, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petition is disposed of in terms of making order dated 29.03.2016 as absolute.
