Report dated 17.02.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Baba Bakala Sahib (Amritsar) has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Harmeet Singh @ Prince, Amanpreet Kaur @ Aman and Jobandeep Singh @ Saido as well as of complainants Kuldeep Singh, Anoop Singh and Satinder Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the same and the fact that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,**

FIR No.68 dated 09.12.2015 under Sections 452,

326,323,324,341,506,148,149 IPC Police Station, Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
