JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Beant Singh in case FIR No. 29, dated 17.03.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 22, 61, 85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

There is recovery of 70 grams intoxicating powder containing salt Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride, which falls within commercial quantity.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 17.03.2015 (except interim bail period w.e.f. 11.05.2015 to 17.12.2015) and the quantity seized is concededly commercial in nature.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Sikander Singh, submits that only one witness out of twelve prosecution witnesses has since been examined.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
