Allegations against the petitioner Govind in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.866 dated 07.11.2015 registered at Police Station I&P Gurgaon, District Gurgaon under Sections 135/138/150 of the Electricity Act, are that on 07.11.2015 he was found illegally extracting electricity.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since last nine months and that the trial will take a long time to conclude, though could not be factually controverted by learned State counsel.

Taking into consideration the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner and the factum of his incarceration, this Court is of the

opinion that further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
