Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.502 dated 6.12.2014 under Sections 148,149, 323, 307,452 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act,PS Saran,Distt.Faridabad.

The petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 24.9.2015.

It was submitted that petitioner was throughout appearing in the trial,however, for his solitary absence on 23.2.2016 his bail bonds had been cancelled and NBWs issued. The reasons for non-appearance is the noting of the wrong date.

Vide order dated 29.3.2016 while issuing notice of motion, petitioner, on surrendering before the trial court within 10 days, was directed to be released on interim bail.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel submits that pursuant to the said order petitioner has surrendered before the trial court on 1.4.2016 and was released on interim bail.

The said factual position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial court pursuant to the order dated 29.3.2016 passed by this court, is made absolute.
