This petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.365, dated 08.09.2015, registered under Sections 395, 397 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station SGM Nagar, District Faridabad.

Learned DAG on instructions from Investigating Officer states that out of 16 witnesses 15 witnesses have been examined and one official witness remains and matter is now fixed for 12.08.2016. He further states

that keeping in view the nature of the offence, instead of releasing the petitioner on bail, it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial since 1 witness remain to be examined. He has stated that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 15.09.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Keeping in view the statement of counsel for the respondent, I dismiss this petition at this stage but direct the trial Court to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution fails to conclude the evidence on or before 15.09.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
