The petitioners seek the quashing of the Circular (Annexure P-4) and seek the substitution of the marks in additional subject for another elective subject in terms of Regulation No.16 followed by circular in March, 2001 and for recasting the result and declaring the same for 10+2 examination in Humanity Group for the year 2002.

A period of 14 years have passed, since the petitioners have passed their 10+2 examination. On the basis of the same they would have carried on their academics and professional pursuits and would in no manner gain in any manner now even if the relief is granted.

The issue now is purely academic. None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners also.

Keeping in view the abovesaid, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous by the sheer efflux of time and is disposed of accordingly.
