FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Kamla Devi and Paramjit Kaur in case FIR No.85 dated 15.02.2016 registered at Police Station Ratia under Sections 323/324/326/506/34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 29.03.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is duly conceded at the bar by learned State counsel and who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and they have not been

assigned any injury on the person of the victim and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide orders dated 29.03.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
