Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.46 dated 31.7.2010 under sections 323, 324, 326, 307, 148, 149 I.P.C (offence under section 307 I.P.C was deleted later on), registered at Police Station, Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

During the course of arguments it has been conceded by counsel that the petitioner having evaded the process of law and having not joined trial proceedings, was declared a Proclaimed Offender. Court, however, has been apprised that co-accused already stands acquitted.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner already stands declared a Proclaimed Offender the prayer seeking concession of pre-arrest bail is declined.

However, keeping in view the peculiar facts, wherein co-accused stand acquitted, it is observed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and thereafter files an application for regular bail, the same would be considered on merits and the court would make every endeavor for early disposal of the same.

Petition disposed of.
