This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in a case vide FIR No.80 dated 12.10.2014 registered under Sections 365/364-A/420/295-A/465/473/120-B/506/34 IPC and 66 IT Act at Police Station, Division No.6, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been incarcerated for a considerable period. Prosecution is not clear about role of the petitioner in crime. Thus, he is entitled to be enlarged on bail.

Prayer has been opposed by learned State counsel. According to him, petitioner was involved in the entire conspiracy to kidnap son of the complainant. He further submits that kidnapped child was recovered by the police from Aligarh (UP) on 21.10.2014. Thus, he has opposed the bail in view of seriousness of allegations.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

FIR was registered against the unknown person as son of the

complainant was abducted allegedly on 12.10.2014 when he was playing in a park. FIR was registered and investigation ensued. During investigation police found that petitioner was in touch with the accused and passing on entire information to them. It is on record that after the child was recovered, he narrated the entire story and named three accused. Petitioner was found involved on the basis of investigation conducted by the investigating agency.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, magnitude of the crime and punishment it would entail in the event of conviction, I am of the considered view that petitioner is not entitled to be enlarged on bail.

Dismissed.
