This order will dispose of CWP No.3052 of 1995 titled *Parvesh Chander Mohindru and others vs. State of Punjab and others* & CWP No.10202 of 1995 titled *Om Parkash Verma and others vs. State of Punjab and another*.

In the written statement, two orders have been attached passed in CWP No.8439 of 1988 titled *Sham Pal and others vs. State of Punjab etc.* decided on February 23, 1994 (Annexure R-1) & CWP No.9256 of 1988 titled *Mathura Dass and others vs. State of Punjab* decided on

February 23, 1994 (Annexure R-2) in which identical orders were passed as follows:-
