JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 7.

2. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that though FIR No. 102 dated August 31, 2015, under Sections 452, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC was registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala but no appropriate action has been taken so far, against respondents No.2 to 4. Even, a representation dated September 02, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and e-mails were made but he has not fetch any fruitful result.

2. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 4 only at this stage.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated September 02, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and subsequent e-mails (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
