Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. filed on behalf of the petitioner-accused-Balwinder Singh alias Billu is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 126, dated 21.06.2014, for offences punishable under Sections 21, 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station C-Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

There is a recovery of 100 grams of intoxicating powder from the possession of petitioner-accused, which as per FSL report was found to be containing *Dyphenoxylate* Powder of the nature of commercial quantity.

The petitioner was released on interim bail on 25.07.2014 awaiting the FSL report, and, thereafter, the petitioner is in custody since 07.05.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Devender Singh, submits that entire prosecution evidence is over and the case is fixed for

defence evidence and arguments before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the advanced stage of the trial and the seized quantity being commercial in nature, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
