Learned counsel for the petitioners has made statement that in the light of order dated 12.7.2016 he withdraws the present petition qua petitioner No.1 Amarjit Kaur and petitioner No.2 Karnail Singh reserving their right to avail appropriate redressal of legal remedy.

Allowed to do so.

Report dated 15.06.2016 sent by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division)-Cum-JMIC Kapurthala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Jaswant Singh and Jasvir Kaur as well as of complainant Bhajan Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and being a case of cross-version and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in *Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543* and *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052*, Rapat No.23 dated 15.2.2015 under Sections 323,147,149 IPC in FIR No.82 dated 17.11.2014 under Sections 323,324,148,149 IPC Police Station, Begowal, District Kapurthala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner No.3-Jaswant Singh and petitionerNo.4-Jasvir Kaur.

Petition stands disposed off.
