The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 68 dated 25.09.2015 registered at Police Station Gardhiwala, District Hoshiarpur under Sections 306, 148, 149 IPC.

Heard.

The petitioner was arrested on 25.09.2015. The charge has been framed and no witness has been examined yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage is over 14 years old and the petitioner had come from Dubai on 20.09.2015 and the wife had consumed poison for the reasons other than what are stated in the FIR and they have three children and the eldest one is 13 years old.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the investigation is over and trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
