Petitioner is a lady who has been in custody w.e.f. 16th February, 2016. As per the story of the prosecution, on 8th February, 2016, petitioner along with three others had come outside the shop of the complainant Nirmal Das @ Nimma and all of them had attacked at the complainant and his daughter with brickbats. There are allegations that the daughter of the complainant had been assaulted with brickbat pebbles. So far as petitioner is concerned, she is attributed a brickbat blow on the head of the daughter of the complainant Neelam @ Neesha.

With the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel, I have gone through the police file.

It has also been informed that a cross-version has also been recorded at the instance of the petitioner's side against the complainant-party. The injury attributed to the petitioner has been declared as dangerous to life by a private hospital at Nawanshehar.

Be that as it may, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 16th February, 2016. She can be granted the concession of bail. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
