For having been found in possession of 150 grams of intoxicating powder containing Diacetylmorphine, the petitioner has been in custody with effect from 07.04.2015.

Despite a period of one year having elapsed and no prosecution witnesses having been examined, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition, at this stage, with a direction that trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to record the statements of all the prosecution witnesses within a period of six months from the next date of hearing. In case, the evidence of the prosecution is not concluded within the above said period, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
