Petitioner is alleged to have assaulted complainant Narinder Kumar with a stick injuring him on lips, teeth, nose and eye.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that challan has already been presented. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f. 28.10.2015. Trial is likely to take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Counsel for the complainant, at this state, has intervened to oppose the bail application contending that the petitioner is involved in few other cases.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant is involved in another case of assault which was registered at the instance of mother of the petitioner under Section 307 IPC.

Taking into consideration the earlier rivalry between the parties, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will, before his release, furnish an affidavit before the trial Court that he will not commit any similar offence in which he is involved and will not make any attempt to tamper evidence.
