Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 49 dated 22.02.2016, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, Distt.Faridkot.

As per allegations, petitioner wife supplied 70 intoxicating tablets to her undertrial husband (in a NDPS case) while he was lodged in prison.

It was contended that the petitioner is an illiterate household lady and there are other sources from which her husband could have secured the tablets in prison.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Naginder Singh, concedes the aforesaid factual situation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 30.03.2016, is made absolute.
