Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 43 dated 27.11.2015, registered under Sections 498-A IPC, Women Police Station, Jhajjar.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 30.3.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
