Petitioner along with his co-accused was found to be in possession of 100 grams of Alprazolam whereas intoxicating powder weighing 100 grams was recovered from his co-accused Subhash Chander. After availing interim bail, during the waiting period of receipt of report of Forensic Science Laboratory, the petitioner has been in custody with effect from 14.03.2016. Any quantity of Alprazolam above 100 grams falls in the commercial quantity. In the present case, the intoxicating powder being 100 grams, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
