This order shall dispose of CRM-M-10783-2016, filed by
petitioner-Ram Piari and CRM-M-13915-2016, filed by petitioner-Jai

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Pal, under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.495 dated 26.08.2015, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, under Sections 302 and 201 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in both the petitions.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A. G. Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, Rubi wife of Jai Pal gave birth to a healthy baby girl on 21.08.2015 at 3.50 a.m. and she was discharged on the same day at 2.00 p.m. from the hospital along with the baby girl. Rubi has earlier two daughters, aged about eight-year old and three and half-year old. There are allegations that Rubi, her husband-Jai Pal (petitioner in CRM-M-13915-2016) and her mother-in-law Ram Piari (petitioner in CRM-M-10783-2016) killed the said baby girl and disposed of her body.

This Court has perused the police file wherein there is a statement of doctor on the record. As per the statement of doctor, Jai Pal (petitioner in CRM-M-13915-2016), Ram Piari (petitioner in CRM-M-10783-2016) and Rubi came to her hospital for delivery and they along with newly born healthy baby girl left the hospital after the discharge of

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Rubi.

Keeping in view the fact that there are serious allegations against the petitioners, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioners are entitled for benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petitions, the same are dismissed.
