Heard.

It comes out that in this case, the cheque was issued by Randhir Singh, one of the partners of the firm M/s Kamal Tractors, Barwala District Hisar. However, Mahender Singh, other partner was also made the accused in the said case. The lower Court has convicted Randhir Singh as the cheque in question bears the signatures of Randhir Singh but acquitted Mahender Singh. There is no evidence on the file to show that Mahender Singh is responsible for running the affairs of the said firm. Since, Randhir Singh has signed the cheque in question, has been convicted by the trial court, no ground for granting leave to appeal is made out.

Accordingly the present application for leave to appeal stands dismissed.
