Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

Learned counsel for the State has produced photocopy of statement of petitioner No.1-*Rajwinder Kaur* to the effect that she does not feel any apprehension at the instance of private respondents. Similarly, the statement of respondent No.4-Harbans Singh, who is father of petitioner No.1-*Rajwinder Kaur*, has also been produced, wherein, he stated that he has not given any threat to the

life and liberty of the petitioners and has no objection to the matrimonial alliance. Statements of petitioner No.1 as well as respondent No.4 produced in Court today, are taken on record.

Without commenting upon the validity of marriage and taking into consideration the statements made by petitioners No.1 & respondent No.4, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the concerned SSP, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
