Heard learned counsel for the rival parties at length. Pursuant to the notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Bhagwan Dass, HPS, Dy. S.P. (HQ), Hisar has been filed. I quote the following extract from para 1 of the reply, as under:-

“... It is pertinent to mention here that the petitioner has filed the present petition with ulterior motive and he has no threat to his life and liberty from the hands of respondent No.4 to 6 as they are police officials and are not concerned with the petitioner in any manner. Rather petitioner is a hard core criminal and indulged in number of criminal cases in the area of District Hisar.”

Accepting the said statement in the reply affidavit of Bhagwan Dass, DSP, I think the petition must come to an end. At the same time, though several offences are reported against the petitioner, the police

authorities are expected to take into consideration the rights of the petitioner as well. In that view of the matter, this petition is disposed of accepting the statement made by the concerned officer.
