JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 for registration of a criminal case against respondent No.5.

2. It has been *inter-alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that though a complaint dated August 28, 2015 (Annexure P-2) was moved to Deputy Commissioner, Nawanshahar (SBS Nagar) but till date no action has been taken on the said complaint. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is issued to disposed of the complaint moved by the petitioner within a stipulated period.

3. Notice to respondents No. 1 to 4 only at this stage

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to Deputy Commissioner Nawanshahar (SBS Nagar) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his complaint/representation dated August 28, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found therein, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of certified copy of this order.
