The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 11 dated 05.02.2016 registered at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Panchkula, Haryana under Sections 323, 328, 34, 376 and 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per his information the petitioner has not joined the investigation and he is not even traceable now and this information has been received from the police.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

On the last date of hearing petitioner was ready to give DNA sample. He has now made himself unavailable. He is not even traceable to the family.

In view of the above, the petitioner is not entitled to discretion of bail. The petition is dismissed.
