Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.5 to 7.

Taking into consideration the nature of dispute, this Court, vide order dated 31.3.2016, had referred the matter to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. However, the

report dated 21.4.2016 of the Mediator shows that mediation proceedings could not take place in absence of the parties.

Learned State counsel has produced the statements of Dilpreet Kaur, petitioner no.1 and her mother Baljit Kaur, respondent no.6, which are taken on record. The statement of respondent no.6 suggests that they have no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners from the private respondents and there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner from them. On the other hand, the statement of petitioner no.1 suggests that there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners and they are living peacefully.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still feel that there is any threat to their life and liberty, they may approach Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, respondent no.3, who shall redress their grievance, if any, in accordance with law.
