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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.189 dated 02.11.2015, under Sections 379/411 IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

On 13.01.2016, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.189 dated 2.11.2015 registered under sections 379, 411 I.P.C at Police Station, Kamboj, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Counsel would submit that the F.I.R in question has been registered on the complaint of Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat of Village Muradpura on the allegations that the present petitioners had assisted one Angrez Singh to harvest crop from a certain parcel of land belonging to the Gram Panchayat.

Counsel would argue that the main accused in the present case is Angrez Singh, who was taken into custody and thereafter has been granted benefit of regular bail. It is submitted that the petitioners are otherwise ready and willing

to join investigation.

Notice of motion, returnable for 4.3.2016.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Davinder Singh apprises the Court that the petitioners have since joined investigation. He further submits that recovery of the paddy crop has also been effected from all the four accused, including the present petitioners.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed. Order dated 13.01.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
