Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.79 dated 02.05.2012, under Sections 419, 465, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur.

During the course of arguments it stands conceded that the petitioner already stands declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 24.09.2014 passed by the Competent Court on account of having evaded the process of law.

Under such circumstances and keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, he is held disentitled to the concession of pre-arrest bail. Reference in this regard may be made to the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in ***State of Madhya Pradesh Vs. Pradeep Sharma 2014 (1) R.C.R. (Criminal) 269.***

Petition dismissed.
