This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.31 dated 12.1.2016 under sections 407, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C registered at Police Station, Matlauda, Panipat.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

F.I.R came to be registered on the statement of Rajesh Kumar i.e. a Manager of a transport company. Allegations were against the owner of a truck namely Sadhu Singh as also a helper namely Satbir Singh to the effect that a consignment of 640 bags of plastic bolls having value of Rs.15 lacs approximately had been given to them but such goods were not delivered at the destination point.

Name of the petitioner does not even figure in the F.I.R.

However, during the course of investigation petitioner was picked-up on 10.2.2016 on the basis that he had allegedly purchased 226 bags of the consignment from the main accused.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan stands presented on 28.4.2016. Charges are yet to be framed. Trial, as such,

would take time to conclude.

Petitioner has faced incarceration for a period of more than three months.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Panipat.

Petition disposed of.
