1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for

grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.55 dated

13.03.2016 registered under Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Ams Act, at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

The allegation is that a foreign made pistol was recovered from the co-accused who disclosed it that he got it from the petitioner who is 70 years old.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 31.03.2016 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ishwar Singh has accedpted this fact and stated that the petitioner is no more required for custodial interrogation. However, she states that other cases are pending against the petitioner.

Be that as it may, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 31.03.2016 is made absolute. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
