Against the judgment dated 22.12.2014 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur acquitting respondents No. 2 to 6 of the charges against them, complainant Rawal Singh @ Bhola has filed the present application for leave to appeal.

Upon notice, respondents No.2 to 6 put in appearance through their counsel.

On the last date of hearing, this Court observed that the dispute between the parties was petty and in order to maintain harmony between them, it would be in the fitness of things to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement. Pursuant to the same, the applicant/complainant, on the one hand, and respondents No.2 to 6, on the other, have put in appearance. When the Court pointed out to them that there was no serious

enmity between the parties and it would be futile exercise to proceed with the matter any further, the Court asked them to go outside the Court and try to sort out the matter. They have, once again, come back to the Court and stated that the dispute between them stands amicably resolved.

In view of the aforementioned development, the applicant as well as his counsel request for withdrawing the application.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
