JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this second petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Charanjit Singh alias Kala in case FIR No. 14, dated 04.02.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66 of E.T. Act, registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala.

As per the case of prosecution, petitioner alongwith his co-accused/non-applicant-Gagandeep Singh murdered Anoop Singh by cutting his neck with the knife and after committing his murder, they burnt his (Anoop Singh) dead body by putting kerosene oil and threw near the drain in the area of V. Khuddi Kalan, as they (accused) wanted to snatch a camera from him. Petitioner and his co-accused also confessed their guilt regarding such offence. Moreover, as per prosecution, petitioner alongwith his co-accused got prepared a fake identity card and on the basis of which, they got issued a sim card through which the deceased (Anoop Singh) was called by them.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Tek Chand, states that the case is at the stage of recording of prosecution evidence.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
